In the Kitchen with KCHO

Cherry Cheesecake Thumbprint Cookies
Prep Time: 10 minutes | Cook Time: 12 minutes
Inactive Time: 45 minutes
Yields: 20 cookies

Ingredients:

4 ounces cream cheese, softened 8 tablespoons salted butter, at room temperature ½ cup + 3 tablespoons sugar 1 cup +3 tablespoons flour ¼ cup cherry preserves

Instructions:

- 1. In the body of a stand mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, beat cream cheese and butter until light and fluffy, scraping down the sides as needed.
- 2. Add the sugar and beat well.
- 3. Add in flour, a small amount at a time, beating in on low speed, just until incorporated.
- 4. Cover bowl with plastic wrap and place in the refrigerator for at least 45 minutes, and up to 2 hours.
- 5. 30 minutes prior to baking, preheat oven to 375 degrees (F).
- 6. Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 7. Using a cookie scoop, scoop out 1 tablespoon sized balls of dough, roll them into rounds, and place them on the cookie sheet.
- 8. Lightly press your thumb in the center of each round ball of dough.
- 9. Fill each indentation with a $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of jam.
- 10. Place pan in the over to bake for 11 to 12 minutes, or until just golden at the edges. They will be very soft when you remove them from the oven.
- 11. Cool on the baking sheet for 10 full minutes, then carefully transfer to a cooling rack to cool completely.
